## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Requesting support for reproductive freedom of choice and family planning and recognizing
- 2 the need for state and federal funds to facilitate a safer environment for mothers and children;
- 3 and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, it is a fundamental constitutional right that individual Americans, not
- 5 government, can best take responsibility for making intensely personal decisions about their
- 6 own reproductive lives; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the best way to make abortion rare is to ensure that individuals have access to
- 8 voluntary family planning, counseling, and information; and
- 9 WHEREAS, international family planning programs save the lives of women and children,
- 10 contribute to the welfare of communities, and create hope for humanity around the globe; and
- 11 WHEREAS, facilitating programs supporting reproductive freedom is an action necessary
- 12 to preserve the safety, integrity, and futures of individuals across the State of Georgia and
- 13 the United States, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that these goals be recognized and
- 14 supported.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 16 the members of this body recognize the need for state and federal funding for reproductive
- 17 health services; age appropriate, medically accurate sex education; and federal funding for
- 18 voluntary international family planning.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Planned Parenthood.
