

## House Resolution 915

## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Offering support on behalf of workers' rights; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the right of workers to join together and form worker organizations is a  
3 fundamental human right recognized worldwide; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the public policy of the United States since the Wagner Act of 1935 has been  
5 to recognize and support the right of workers to bargain collectively by representatives of  
6 their own choosing; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Republican majorities in the legislatures of the states of Georgia, Wisconsin,  
8 Ohio, Indiana, New Hampshire, Idaho, and 17 other states have gone on record opposing the  
9 fundamental rights of public and private employees to bargain collectively; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the principles of democracy and the people of Georgia oppose this restriction  
11 on workers' rights.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
13 the members of this body go on record to offer support on behalf of workers' rights.
- 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
15 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Georgia State AFL-CIO  
16 PAA.
