A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Don R. Connell on the occasion of his retirement; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Dr. Don R. Connell, a board certified radiologist, has earnestly and
4 conscientiously devoted over 30 years of his time, talents, and energy serving the residents
5 of Bulloch County and surrounding areas; and

6 WHEREAS, he diligently read and supervised thousands of radiologic results vital in the
7 diagnosis and treatment of diseases and injuries; and

8 WHEREAS, he attended Berry College and the University of Georgia, graduated from the
9 Medical College of Georgia in 1978, and completed his residency at Memorial Hospital in
10 Savannah, Georgia, where he was chief resident from 1981 to 1982; and

17 member of the Radiologic Technology Program at Ogeechee Technical College; and

19 sweetheart, Connie, and is blessed with three children, Christopher, Spencer, and Anslee; and

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Connell has worked with distinction and sacrifice and his unyielding
21 commitment to the health of his patients will be sorely missed upon the occasion of his

22 retirement, and it is abundantly fitting that the outstanding accomplishments of this
23 distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
