A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Coach Lindsey Huffman on her superlative leadership as head
2 coach of the Reinhardt University women's basketball team; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Coach Huffman has joined the Reinhardt University athletic department as the
4 head coach of the women's basketball team and is in charge of handling all aspects associated
5 with Reinhardt's intercollegiate women's basketball program; and

6 WHEREAS, in her first season as head coach and under her astute direction, the team
7 garnered the 2013 Appalachian Athletic Conference championship title; and

8 WHEREAS, she has exhibited the highest level of leadership, integrity, and compassion for
9 the student athletes she has coached and taught, instilling in them the principles of humility
10 and good sportsmanship; and

11 WHEREAS, Coach Huffman is a graduate of Etowah High School where she was a varsity
12 starter and is still the school's all-time leading scorer with 1,735 points; and

13 WHEREAS, Coach Huffman received her bachelor's and master's degrees in physical
14 education from North Georgia College and State University in 2007 and 2009, respectively;
15 a standout guard as a player, she helped guide North Georgia to a 23-4 overall record and the
16 2006 Peach Belt Conference regular-season title in the Lady Saints' first year of competition
17 at the NCAA Division II level; and

18 WHEREAS, before beginning her career at Reinhardt University, Coach Huffman worked
19 for three seasons as an assistant women's basketball coach for North Georgia College and
20 State University; before that, she was an assistant coach and special education
21 paraprofessional at Roswell High School for one year, helping to lead the Lady Hornets to
22 the 2009 Region 6-AAAAA championship and a state tournament appearance; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the efforts of this exemplary Georgian
24 in helping the students of this state refine their skills and achieve new heights of excellence
25 be recognized.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
27 the members of this body recognize Coach Lindsey Huffman for her tremendously successful
28 first season as head coach of the Reinhardt University women's basketball team, commend
29 her on leading the team to an AAC victory, and extend their sincere best wishes for future
30 success.
