A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating Dr. Paul Cerpovicz; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Dr. Paul Cerpovicz, associate professor of chemistry at East Georgia State
3 College, was selected as the recipient of the 2013 Regents' Teaching Excellence Award for
4 faculty in two-year and state colleges; and

5 WHEREAS, Dr. Cerpovicz received his bachelor's degree in biology from Westfield State
6 College and his Ph.D. in biochemistry from Kansas State University; and

7 WHEREAS, he has been teaching since 1995, and in 2002, he joined the faculty at East
8 Georgia State College; and

9 WHEREAS, his colleagues and associates describe his enthusiasm for chemistry, education,
10 and quality instruction as contagious, and they agree that he has consistently combined his
11 superb scientific knowledge, his commitment to excellent teaching, his desire to strive for
12 continuous assessment and improvement, and his dedication to student learning to become
13 a role model for the kind of teacher that the University System of Georgia desires to attract
14 and retain; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
16 remarkable Georgian be appropriately recognized.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 congratulate Dr. Paul Cerpovicz for being selected as the recipient of the 2013 Regents'
19 Teaching Excellence Award for faculty in two-year and state colleges.
