

ADOPTED

Senators Orrock of the 36th, Mullis of the 53rd and McKoon of the 29th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend HB 189 (LC 40 0340S) by inserting after "authority;" on line 5 "to amend Code*
2 *Section 36-37-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to disposition of*
3 *municipal property generally, so as to provide for the transfer of certain park property;" and*
4 *inserting after line 23 the following:*

SECTION 1A.

6 Code Section 36-37-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to disposition of
7 municipal property generally, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

8 "(m) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a city may exchange
9 property dedicated as a city park with an institution owning property in or abutting a
10 federal National Historic Site for use in connection with such property, provided that the
11 city receives property in fee simple that is of equal or greater acreage as the city property
12 exchanged and that the city immediately dedicates the property as a public park."
