ADOPTED

Senators Orrock of the 36th, Mullis of the 53rd and McKoon of the 29th offered the following amendment:

Amend HB 189 (LC 40 0340S) by inserting after "authority;" on line 5 "to amend Code
Section 36-37-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to disposition of
municipal property generally, so as to provide for the transfer of certain park property;" and
inserting after line 23 the following:

SECTION 1A.

Code Section 36-37-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to disposition of
municipal property generally, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

8 "(m) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a city may exchange

- 9 property dedicated as a city park with an institution owning property in or abutting a
- 10 <u>federal National Historic Site for use in connection with such property, provided that the</u>
- 11 <u>city receives property in fee simple that is of equal or greater acreage as the city property</u>
- 12 exchanged and that the city immediately dedicates the property as a public park."
