ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the potential of wind energy and encouraging local governments to take the
- 2 steps necessary to create an open dialogue with local stakeholders and potential wind energy
- 3 developers in order to inform the public and maximize the potential for implementation of
- 4 available wind resources; and for other purposes.
- 5 WHEREAS, onshore wind energy provides enough electricity to power nearly 15 million
- 6 American homes annually and employs over 75,000 people in the United States; and
- 7 WHEREAS, offshore wind represents a significant source of clean, renewable energy; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the outer continental shelf off the Georgia coast includes 1,126 square miles of
- 9 area potentially suitable for offshore wind farms with up to 14.5 gigawatts of generating
- 10 capacity, enough to power nearly 3 million homes or one-third of Georgia's electricity; and
- 11 WHEREAS, wind is a domestic source of energy that is shielded from foreign interests and
- 12 represents one of the largest, cheapest sources of power that poses no significant harm to the
- 13 environment; and
- 14 WHEREAS, wind power is a proven, growing domestic energy market, as evidenced by
- wind power representing the largest source of new power generating capacity in 2012 in the
- 16 United States; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the Port of Savannah, the fastest growing port in the nation, may serve as a
- 18 gateway for the global wind energy market that is expected to grow by hundreds of billions
- 19 of dollars in the next five years; and
- 20 WHEREAS, wind energy projects offer stable prices over as much as a 20 year period in
- 21 contrast to the volatile costs of fossil fuels; and

22 WHEREAS, wind development is dependent upon supportive local policies and public

- 23 opinion.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 25 encourage local governments to recognize wind energy as an important source of clean
- 26 energy and a significant job-creating industry; invite wind energy developers and
- 27 manufacturers to meet with Georgia public officials to further Georgia's advancement in
- 28 wind energy; and request that educational institutions and wind energy developers train and
- 29 utilize the local workforce and human resources of Georgia to plan, site, construct, and
- 30 operate future projects.
- 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 32 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy.
