A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Commissioner John Quinn for his loyal service to the City of
2 Avondale Estates and its residents; and for other purposes.

4 Avondale Estates; and

5 WHEREAS, Avondale Estates was founded in 1924 by George Francis Willis, who
6 purchased the entire village of Ingleside to create a planned community; and

7 WHEREAS, the city was named after Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwickshire, England, the
8 birthplace of William Shakespeare; and

9 WHEREAS, downtown buildings were designed in a Tudor style to reinforce this image, as
10 were many of the houses in the city; and

11 WHEREAS, Avondale Estates has 2,960 residents and is known for its close-knit
12 community, beautiful setting, and diverse architectural styles; and

13 WHEREAS, Commissioner Quinn has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable
14 hours of his time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of Avondale Estates and its
15 residents; and

16 WHEREAS, he has served with honor and distinction as commissioner, and it is abundantly
17 fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this distinguished Georgian be
18 appropriately recognized.
