A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the 2012 Child Fatality Review Committee of the Year from
2 Floyd County; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Floyd County was recognized as having the 2012 Child Fatality Review
4 Committee of the Year; and

5 WHEREAS, the Floyd County Child Fatality Review Committee is working to review and
6 discuss different portions of the protocol and update them if necessary; this past year,
7 updates included a new mandated reporting law and new measures to improve prevention
8 efforts; and

9 WHEREAS, the committee has started a prevention effort with snuggle nests and
10 co-sleepers; and

11 WHEREAS, the prevention effort involved showing the Period of Purple Crying video in the
12 pediatric unit of Floyd Medical Center and providing mothers of newborns who fit the
13 committee's criteria with information on the back to sleep campaign; and

14 WHEREAS, possibly as a result of this new prevention effort, there were no infant fatalities
15 in Floyd County due to bed sharing in 2012; and

16 WHEREAS, taking the initiative to create new and innovative programs, this committee's
17 goal is to help protect children; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with particularity
19 the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary committee.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
21 the members of this body join together to recognize the 2012 Child Fatality Review

22 Committee of the Year from Floyd County and commend its members for their outstanding
23 service to their community and this state.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
25 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Floyd County Child
26 Fatality Review Committee.
