A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

| To amend Code Section 20-2-1180 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to |

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

Code Section 20-2-1180 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to loitering upon school premises or within a school safety zone, penalty, required check in of visitors, and posting signs of required check in, is amended by revising subsection (f) as follows:

"(f) Nothing in this Code section shall be construed to prohibit prevent school administrators from prohibiting the admission of any person who has violated school policy or state law; provided, however, that prior to the imposition of a ban by a school administrator prohibiting the admission of a parent or guardian of one or more children in a school, the parent or guardian shall have the right to make a written request for and shall be entitled to a hearing before a panel. Such panel shall include an independent person who is not employed at the school. The local board of education shall establish procedures and timelines for requesting and conducting such hearing."

SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
