A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 3 of Title 30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to access
- 2 to and use of public facilities by persons with disabilities, so as to provide for increased
- 3 accessibility by the blind and visually impaired to the state capitol and legislative office
- 4 facilities; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 3 of Title 30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to access to and use
- 8 of public facilities by persons with disabilities, is amended by adding a new Code section to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 "30-3-3.1.
- 11 Notwithstanding all other requirements provided for in this chapter, all permanent signs,
- 12 <u>including room identification signs, directional and informational signs, and elevator car</u>
- 13 signs, in the state capitol and Coverdell Legislative Office Building shall incorporate tactile
- 14 <u>characters and Braille using standards set forth by ADAAG."</u>

SECTION 2.

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
