A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

| 1 | To amend Code Section 48-7-29.16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to |
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| 2 | the qualified education tax credit, so as to increase the aggregate amount of tax credits; to |
| 3 | provide for an effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other |
| 4 | purposes. |
| 5 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: |
| 6 | SECTION 1. |
| 7 | Code Section 48-7-29.16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the qualified |
| 8 | education tax credit, is amended by revising paragraph (1) of subsection (f) as follows: |
| 9 | ''(f)(1) In no event shall the aggregate amount of tax credits allowed under this Code |
| 10 | section exceed \$58 \$100 million per tax year." |
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| 11 | SECTION 2. |
| 12 | This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law |
| 13 | without such approval and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning on or after |
| 14 | January 1, 2014. |
