A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing January 22, 2014, as Armstrong Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Armstrong Atlantic State University is a dynamic public university with more
3 than 7,100 undergraduate and graduate students; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Armstrong is Savannah's teaching-first university where professors devote
5 themselves to the classroom and equip ambitious students with the skills and habits of mind
6 to transition confidently into the professional world; and
- 7 WHEREAS, over 100 academic programs are offered within the College of Education,
8 College of Health Professions, College of Liberal Arts, College of Sciences and Technology,
9 and Graduate Studies; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Armstrong's College of Health Professions has been the number one producer
11 of health professionals within the University System of Georgia since 2007; and
- 12 WHEREAS, students within Armstrong's College of Health Professions learn to improve the
13 health and wellness of their culturally diverse communities through a team-oriented,
14 evidence-focused, and compassionate approach to practice; and
- 15 WHEREAS, students and faculty from Armstrong's College of Health Professions will
16 demonstrate these skills through an interactive showcase of health profession programs today
17 at the state capitol.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize January 22, 2014, as Armstrong Day at the state capitol.
