A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Max Cummins on achieving the rank of Eagle Scout; and for
2 other purposes.

15 demonstrated by his completion of an exceptional community service project through raising
16 funds for and the beautification of Southland Academy in Americus, Georgia; and

17 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Max has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
18 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
19 becoming of an Eagle Scout; and

20 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
21 has brought great pride to his family, friends, and community, and Max Cummins stands as
22 a positive example for all Georgians.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body recognize and commend Max Cummins for his diligence and
25 dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and
26 congratulate him on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
