A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Special Agent Lt. Benjamin Louis Sentell and dedicating a road in his
2 memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens and most dedicated law
4 enforcement officers with the tragic passing of Special Agent Lt. Benjamin Louis Sentell on
5 March 3, 1966; and

6 WHEREAS, a native of Waynesboro, Georgia, Special Agent Sentell attended the 3rd
7 Trooper School and was assigned to service in Waynesboro; and

8 WHEREAS, this dedicated law enforcement officer's life was cut short when he was killed
9 in a patrol car crash on State Route 24 near Louisville, Georgia; and

10 WHEREAS, Special Agent Sentell exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding
11 loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his duties.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
13 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of Ga. 24 from the western city limit of
14 Waynesboro to the intersection of Ga. 305 is dedicated as the Special Agent Lt. Benjamin
15 Louis Sentell Memorial Highway.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
17 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Special Agent Lt. Benjamin
18 Louis Sentell Memorial Highway.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
20 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the family of Special Agent
21 Lt. Benjamin Louis Sentell and to the Department of Transportation.
