A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 44-3-106 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 powers and responsibilities of condominium associations and tort actions, so as to clarify
- 3 provisions relating to the standing of the association to participate in litigation under certain
- 4 circumstances; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 44-3-106 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the powers and
- 9 responsibilities of condominium associations and tort actions, is amended by revising
- 10 subsection (h) as follows:
- 11 "(h) The association shall have the capacity, power, and standing to institute, intervene in,
- prosecute, represent in, or defend, in its own name, litigation, administrative or other
- proceedings of any kind concerning claims or other matters relating to any portions of the
- units or common elements which the association has the responsibility to administer,
- repair, or maintain. It is the public policy of this state that such capacity, power, and
- standing shall not be waived, abridged, modified, or removed by any provision of any
- 17 <u>contract or document, including the condominium instruments, that were recorded, entered</u>
- into, or established prior to the expiration of the period of the declarant's right to control
- the association as set forth in subsection (a) of Code Section 44-3-101."

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
