A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-5-7.4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to ad
- 2 valorem taxation of bona fide conservation use property, so as to provide that operation of
- 3 a skeet shooting range shall not constitute another type of business for qualification as
- 4 conservation use property for current use assessment; to provide for an effective date; to
- 5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 48-5-7.4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to ad valorem
- 9 taxation of bona fide conservation use property, is amended by revising paragraph (1) of
- 10 subsection (b) as follows:

- 11 "(1) When one-half or more of the area of a single tract of real property is used for a
- qualifying purpose, then such tract shall be considered as used for such qualifying
- purpose unless some other type of business is being operated on the unused portion;
- provided, however, that such unused portion must shall be minimally managed so that it
- does not contribute significantly to erosion or other environmental or conservation
- problems. The lease of hunting rights or the use of the property for hunting purposes shall
- 17 not constitute another type of business. <u>Operation of a skeet shooting range</u>, whether for
- profit or not, shall not constitute another type of business. The charging of admission for

use of the property for fishing purposes shall not constitute another type of business;"

- SECTION 2.
- 21 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2015, and shall apply to all tax years beginning
- on or after that date.
- SECTION 3.
- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
