

Senate Resolution 789

A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Shoal Creek Water Reclamation Facility (WRF); and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, during the Georgia Association of Water Professionals (GAWP) Spring
4 Conference, Shoal Creek WRF took home the coveted Wastewater Plant of the Year Award
5 for the 3.0-5.9 MGD Advanced Treatment Category; and

6 WHEREAS, along with winning the award, Shoal Creek WRF also received the highest
7 inspection score, a 108, of all the facility categories inspected for the Wastewater Plant of
8 the Year Award; and

9 WHEREAS, GAWP's Plant of the Year competition program is conducted state wide and
10 includes a comprehensive on-site evaluation performed by an expert technical inspection
11 team; and

12 WHEREAS, the plant inspection lasts for five to six hours and encompasses every aspect of
13 running the facility, including the plant operations, safety program, in-house training, and
14 public education program; and

15 WHEREAS, all of the systems under review possess examples of exceptional operation but
16 only a select few, such as Shoal Creek WRF, rise to the top during this exhaustive process;

18 WHEREAS, along with the Plant of the Year Award, Shoal Creek WRF received a GAWP
19 Platinum Award for meeting all of its permit requirements.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 recognize the Shoal Creek Water Reclamation Facility and commend it on receiving the
22 Wastewater Plant of the Year Award.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
24 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Shoal Creek Water Reclamation
25 Facility.
