## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Charles Carroll Castleberry; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Charles Carroll Castleberry on February 12, 2012; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Castleberry served his fellow man in many ways throughout his life,  
5 working to make Forsyth County and the State of Georgia a better place to live through his  
6 civic, agricultural, and church involvement; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to Florene Whitmire Castleberry for 64  
8 years and was blessed with wonderful children and grandchildren; and
- 9 WHEREAS, his commitment to serving his county and state is ably demonstrated by his 12  
10 years of service on the Forsyth County Board of Education, his two terms on the Forsyth  
11 County Planning and Zoning Board, his eight years of service on the Forsyth County  
12 Hospital Board, his nine years of service on the Forsyth County ASCS Board, his two terms  
13 on the Georgia State ASCS State Committee, his 40 years of work with AG-GA Farm Credit,  
14 and his work on the Georgia Farm Bureau Poultry Advisory Committee, Forsyth County  
15 Board of Equalization, Forsyth County Farm Bureau, and FSA County Committee for  
16 Dawson, Hall, Forsyth, and Lumpkin counties; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
18 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
19 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 20 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
21 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he  
22 made this world a better place in which to live; and

24 remembered for his love of family and friendship, and this loyal family man and friend will  
25 be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
