A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Deja Shimone Fambro; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Deja Shimone Fambro is an 18 year old honor student who attends North
3 Clayton Comprehensive High School; and

4 WHEREAS, Deja is actively involved in multiple academic and extracurricular activities,
5 such as Distributive Education Clubs of America, Future Business Leaders of America,
6 Morehouse Talent Search, the morning broadcasting team, Ladies of F.I.R.E., National Art
7 Honors Society, and the co-op work study program, and she is a teacher aide and front office
8 aide and serves as vice president of the Green Team; and

9 WHEREAS, Deja is an active leader not only at her school, but also in her community,
10 working on several political campaigns and standing up for many causes; and

11 WHEREAS, she played an integral part in raising \$30,000.00 to transport two busloads of
12 her school mates and parents from North Clayton Middle School to the historical 2009
13 inauguration of President Barack Obama; and

14 WHEREAS, Deja has an unwavering passion for aviation and aerospace and has been a
15 flight student on nights and weekends at Aviation Career Enrichment Academy in Atlanta,
16 Georgia, since she was 15; she was selected to be on the 2010-2011 Delta Dream flight for
17 future aviators and was one of two students to represent Delta Airlines at the 83rd annual
18 American Association of Airport Executives Convention; and

19 WHEREAS, she was nominated as one of four students to participate in Maynard Jackson
20 Youth Leadership Foundation, and she represented the City of Atlanta as a student
21 ambassador on a study abroad trip to Barcelona and Madrid, Spain, and France in the
22 summer of 2013; and

23 WHEREAS, Deja Shimone Fambro plans to attend Middle Georgia State College and pursue
24 a Bachelor of Science in aviation management with a concentration in flight; upon
25 graduation, she hopes to enter the United States Air Force as an officer, so she can be the first
26 African American female to pilot Air Force One.
