## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February as Career and Technical Education Month and February 11, 2014, as  
2 Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations Day at the state capitol; and for other  
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, organizations such as CTI, DECA, FBLA, FCCLA, FFA, HOSA, SkillsUSA,  
5 and TSA, along with career, technical, and agricultural education, provide a solid  
6 establishment for the youth of America and for the future business and economic  
7 development in our state; and

8 WHEREAS, career and technical student organizations promote occupational excellence,  
9 leadership, and citizenship among their members who are preparing for the workforce and  
10 further education; and

11 WHEREAS, career and technical student organizations in Georgia are an integral and  
12 co-curricular component for career, technical, and agricultural education programs, which  
13 are designed to support instructional objectives and attainment of academic and technical  
14 competencies; and

15 WHEREAS, they provide an opportunity for students not only to gain confidence and  
16 knowledge through competition, but also to become more motivated in becoming better  
17 students and more productive citizens, which in turn develops school and community leaders.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
19 recognize February as Career and Technical Education Month and February 11, 2014, as  
20 Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations Day at the state capitol.
