A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Tyler William Smedley; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Tyler William Smedley has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most
3 distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and Tyler
8 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competence in mastering the various special skills taught
9 through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 505 in Monroe, Georgia,
11 and has demonstrated great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy
12 Scouts of America; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he served as quartermaster, senior patrol leader, chaplain's aide, and troop
14 guide, attended both Camp Sidney Dew and Camp Ho Non Wah, and was recently
15 nominated for Order of the Arrow; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Tyler has devoted much time to volunteering for Faith in Serving Humanity,
17 Toys for Tots, the Special Olympics in Walton County, and Central Presbyterian Night
18 Shelter in Atlanta, Georgia; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Tyler is a member of his Junior Beta Club, was on the principal's list for high
20 academic achievement, earned the Golden Carver Wildcat Award, and interviewed a World
21 War II veteran in StoryCorps, which will be filed in the Library of Congress in Washington,

22 D.C.; and for his Eagle project, Tyler placed a flag pole in the Good Hope Christian
23 Cemetery, dedicating it in honor of the veterans of the United States Armed Forces; and

24 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Tyler William Smedley has truly exhibited a
25 commitment to the scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently
26 conducted himself in a manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

27 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
28 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
30 the members of this body commend Tyler William Smedley for his diligence and dedication
31 in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him
32 for attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
