A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Madison Weeks for outstanding achievement as a FFA member; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the mission of FFA is to make a positive difference in the lives of students by
4 developing their potential for premier leadership, personal growth, and career success
5 through agricultural education; and

6 WHEREAS, Madison Weeks is an active member of the Colquitt County FFA Chapter in
7 Moultrie, Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, Madison Weeks has exhibited lambs and goats since she was in the fifth grade,
9 exhibiting them at the State Lamb and Goat Show each year; and since joining the Colquitt
10 County FFA, she has served as a FFA officer; and

11 WHEREAS, during the 2013 Georgia National Fair, Madison Weeks placed first in both
12 State Lamb and Goat Showmanship at the State Lamb and Goat Show in Perry, Georgia; she
13 placed first in lamb showmanship out of 25 exhibitors and first in goat showmanship out of
14 60 exhibitors; and

15 WHEREAS, this is the first time in the history of the State Lamb and Goat Show that one
16 student has won both of these events in the same year at the same time, making this a very
17 special accomplishment; and

18 WHEREAS, Madison Weeks has also excelled at other FFA activities, such as being State
19 High Individual in the State FFA Meats Evaluation Event in Athens, Georgia, all while
20 maintaining an A/B average in school; and

21 WHEREAS, Colquitt County FFA is very proud to have Madison Weeks as one of their
22 successful members who represents the chapter well.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body recognize the outstanding achievements of Madison Weeks,
25 commend her for being the first student to win both events at the State Lamb and Goat Show,
26 and encourage her to continue to pursue excellence in all her endeavors.
