A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 15-6-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
2	number of superior court judges for each judicial circuit, so as to provide for an additional
3	judge of the Waycross Judicial Circuit; to provide for the initial appointment of such judge
4	by the Governor; to provide for the election and term of office of such judge; to provide for
5	powers, duties, and responsibilities of such judge and the judges of such circuit; to provide
6	for effective dates; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
7	purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9	SECTION 1.
10	Code Section 15-6-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the number of
11	superior court judges for each judicial circuit, is amended by revising paragraph (41) as
12	follows:
13	"(41) Waycross Circuit
14	SECTION 2.
15	A new judge of the superior court is added to the Waycross Judicial Circuit, thereby
16	increasing to four the number of judges of such circuit.
17	SECTION 3.
18	The initial judge appointed as provided by this Act shall be appointed by the Governor for
19	a term beginning July 1, 2014, and expiring December 31, 2016, and until a successor is
20	elected and qualified. A successor to the initial judge shall be elected in a manner provided
21	by Code Section 21-2-138 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated for the election of
22	judges of the superior courts of this state in 2016 for a term of four years beginning on
23	January 1, 2017, and until the election and qualification of a successor. Future successors
24	shall be elected each four years thereafter as provided by Code Section 21-2-138 of the

25 Official Code of Georgia Annotated for terms of four years and until the election and

- 26 qualification of a successor. They shall take office on the first day of January following the
- 27 date of the election. Such elections shall be held and conducted in a manner provided by law
- 28 for the election of judges of the superior courts of this state.

SECTION 4.

- 30 Such additional judge shall have and may exercise all powers, duties, dignity, jurisdiction,
- 31 privileges, and immunities of the present judges of the superior courts of this state. Any of
- 32 the judges of the superior court of such circuit may preside over any case therein and perform
- any official act as judge thereof.

34 SECTION 5.

- 35 (a) For purposes of making the initial appointment of the judge to fill the superior court
- 36 judgeship created by this Act, this Act shall become effective upon its approval by the
- 37 Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
- 38 (b) For all other purposes, this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2014.

39 **SECTION 6.**

40 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
