11 Georgia, and has demonstrated great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the
12 Boy Scouts of America; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he served as senior patrol leader of the troop and assistant senior patrol leader
14 for the Milton District Scout Jamboree, and he was motivated to advance from Tenderfoot
15 to Eagle in only two years; and
- 16 WHEREAS, for his Eagle project, Aubrey constructed a large storage shed for Grace Chapel
17 Church of Christ; and
- 18 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Aubrey has truly exhibited a commitment to the
19 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
20 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader

22 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body commend Aubrey Haley for his diligence and dedication in
25 pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him for
26 attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
