#### A RESOLUTION

12 either as a paper, exhibit, performance, documentary, or website; and

13 WHEREAS, these two exemplary Georgia students represented their state with pride,  
14 dedication, and creativity unmatched by many at the National History Day Competition; and

15 WHEREAS, as these magnificent students earned their well-deserved reputation for  
16 excellence by performing diligent research, it is abundantly proper to commend them for  
17 their accomplishments.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
19 the members of this body commend Katie Yount and Nathan Wright on representing the  
20 State of Georgia and earning their respective titles at the National History Day Competition,

22 determined by the Speaker of the House.
