## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Effingham County High School for their participation in STEM Outreach and  
2 Education via the Molecular Biology Initiative of Georgia Southern University; and for other  
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) Outreach and  
5 Education program utilizes supplies and equipment provided by the Molecular Biology  
6 Initiative (MBI) in association with fellows from Georgia Southern University graduate  
7 schools; and

8 WHEREAS, fellows are paired with science teachers from local high schools to teach one  
9 time per week using current technologies and knowledge; and

10 WHEREAS, this program assists teachers in providing more comprehensive and modern  
11 lessons to their students; and

12 WHEREAS, in addition to helping teachers, STEM Outreach and Education also allows for  
13 Georgia Southern fellows to glean real world experience in the application and teaching of  
14 their areas of study; and

15 WHEREAS, fellows develop learning modules that are placed online and nationally available  
16 for no charge after being vetted by the Georgia Southern University School of Education; and

17 WHEREAS, MBI is recognized by the National Science Foundation, the American  
18 Association for the Advancement of Science, and the Technology Association of Georgia.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
20 recognize Effingham County High School for their participation in STEM Outreach  
21 Education and commend the Molecular Biology Initiative of Georgia Southern University.
