A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 31-7-12.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 unlicensed personal care homes, so as to provide for criminal penalties for owning or
- 3 operating an unlicensed personal care home; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 31-7-12.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to unlicensed
- 8 personal care homes, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 9 "(g) It is declared that the owning or operating of an unlicensed personal care home in this
- 10 <u>state constitutes a nuisance dangerous to the public health, safety, and welfare. Any person</u>
- who owns or operates an unlicensed personal care home in violation of subsection (b) of
- 12 <u>Code Section 31-7-12 shall be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction, shall be punished</u>
- by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five years and, in the discretion of the
- trial judge, as for a misdemeanor; provided, however, that upon a second or subsequent
- conviction, he or she shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one nor more
- than ten years."

17 SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
