The Senate Health and Human Services Committee offered the following substitute to HB 513:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, so as to
2	abolish the Georgia Medical Center Authority; to provide for related matters; to provide an
3	effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
5	SECTION 1.
6	Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, is amended by
7	repealing in its entirety Chapter 15, relating to the Georgia Medical Center Authority, and
8	designating said chapter as reserved.
9	SECTION 2.
10	As of the effective date of this Act, the Georgia Medical Center Authority is abolished and
11	shall cease to exist.
12	SECTION 3.

- (a) Any funds held by the Georgia Medical Center Authority as of the effective date of this
 Act shall be paid to the state treasury and become a part of the general funds of the state.
- 15 (b) On the effective date of this Act, any outstanding contracts, licenses, and obligations of
- the Georgia Medical Center Authority shall be transferred to the Board of Regents of the
 University System of Georgia until the same are completed or extinguished.

18SECTION 4.19This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law20without such approval.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
