A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Cadet Ricky W. Leslie and recognizing February 12, 2014, as Ricky Leslie
2 Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Cadet Ricky W. Leslie has demonstrated his commitment to hard work,
4 sacrifice, and his country by returning to school and the Reserve Officer Training Corps
5 through the Army Green to Gold Program after serving eight years as an enlistee in the
6 regular Army to pursue his goal of becoming a commissioned officer and continuing to serve

9 in service to his country during four deployments to Afghanistan and Yemen; and

13 WHEREAS, he has served as a role model for his fellow Columbus State University cadets;

16 the United States, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary accomplishments
17 and commitment of Cadet Ricky W. Leslie be honored.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 commend Columbus State University graduate student Cadet Ricky W. Leslie on his
20 achievement as the United States Army Cadet Command's ROTC Cadet of the Year and
21 recognize February 12, 2014, as Ricky Leslie Day at the state capitol.
