A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Corporal Tyrone Collier Dillard and dedicating a road in his memory;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens and most dedicated law
4 enforcement officers with the tragic passing of Corporal Tyrone Collier Dillard on February
5 3, 1977; and

6 WHEREAS, a native of Athens, Georgia, Corporal Dillard attended the 32nd Trooper School
7 and was assigned to service at Post 6 in Gainesville, Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, this dedicated law enforcement officer's life was cut short when he was killed
9 while directing traffic on Ga. 129 near Gainesville; and

10 WHEREAS, Corporal Dillard exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding loyalty,
11 fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his duties.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
13 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of Ga. 11 from its intersection with I-985 to the
14 Jackson County line is dedicated as the Corporal Tyrone Collier Dillard Memorial Highway.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
16 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Corporal Tyrone Collier
17 Dillard Memorial Highway.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
19 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the family of Corporal Tyrone
20 Collier Dillard and to the Department of Transportation.
