#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Leo Moore; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, growing up in Mobile, Alabama, Leo Moore was no stranger to the medical  
3 field as his mother, grandmother, and aunt all worked as nurses; as a child he developed a  
4 sincere yearning to care for people; and

5 WHEREAS, as an undergraduate at Columbus State University, Leo Moore joined Eta Sigma  
6 Gamma, a health education honors society, and became actively involved in AIDS  
7 awareness, helping organize the university's observance of World AIDS Day, which will be  
8 headed into its seventh year in 2014; and

9 WHEREAS, after graduating magna cum laude from Columbus State University in 2007  
10 with Bachelor of Science in biology, Leo Moore decided to pursue his passion for helping  
11 people with a career in medicine, particularly internal medicine; and

12 WHEREAS, by the time Leo Moore graduated from Morehouse College in 2011 with his  
13 medical degree, he had gone on two goodwill missions to practice medicine in Haiti and  
14 Uganda, experiences that gave him an international perspective on medicine; and

15 WHEREAS, after finishing at Morehouse, Leo Moore was accepted as a primary care  
16 internal medicine resident at Yale University, where he's currently studying; and

17 WHEREAS, he will start work in July as a participant in the Robert Wood Johnson Clinical  
18 Scholars program at the University of California at Los Angeles, which is considered one of  
19 the most prestigious fellowships awarded to physicians; and

20 WHEREAS, helping people and trying to find new ways to boost awareness of AIDS, he  
21 believes students should never give up on their dreams, words that helped fuel his academic  
22 journey.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
24 recognize Leo Moore for his academic achievement and contributions to medicine and  
25 extend the sincerest best wishes for his continued success.
