A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta is an organization of women committed
3 to promoting volunteerism, developing the potential of women, and improving the
4 community through the effective action of trained volunteers; and

5 WHEREAS, the purpose of the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta is exclusively educational
6 and charitable; and

7 WHEREAS, the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta is a catalyst for community change by
8 creating a legacy of service to the children and families of Cobb County; and

9 WHEREAS, the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta reaches out to women of all races,
10 religions, and national origins who demonstrate an interest in and commitment to
11 volunteerism; and

12 WHEREAS, in 2013 the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta celebrated 80 years as a defining
13 force in Cobb County by creating programs, services, and organizations to meet the
14 ever-changing needs of the Cobb County community; and

15 WHEREAS, the organization founded the Center for Children & Young Adults and the Cobb
16 County Youth Museum, to making a difference with more recent projects such as Cobb
17 County Safety Village and Cobb County Diaper Day; and

18 WHEREAS, the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta listens to the pulse of the community and
19 responds with trained, passionate volunteers who are ready to make an instant and
20 measurable impact; and

21 WHEREAS, through Community Projects and Done in a Day programs, the members of the
22 Junior League of Cobb-Marietta contribute more than 10,000 hours to the Cobb community
23 each year; and

24 WHEREAS, partnering with organizations that reflect our mission of service to the children
25 and families of Cobb County, the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta continues to be
26 instrumental in identifying and meeting community needs through volunteer assistance and
27 financial contributions; and

28 WHEREAS, the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta is an active participant of the State Public
29 Affairs Committee of the Junior Leagues of Georgia that each year follows issues concerning
30 education, health, and welfare such as human trafficking, cyber crimes, spousal and child
31 abuse, childhood obesity and bullying, and develops legislative strategies to improve and
32 inspire Georgia's communities.

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
34 commend the over 350 active, senior active, provisional and sustaining members of the
35 Junior League of Cobb-Marietta for their service and dedication to the citizenry of Cobb
36 County and the State of Georgia.
