- 25 and families of Cobb County, the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta continues to be
- 26 instrumental in identifying and meeting community needs through volunteer assistance and
- 27 financial contributions; and
- WHEREAS, the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta is an active participant of the State Public Affairs Committee of the Junior Leagues of Georgia that each year follows issues concerning education, health, and welfare such as human trafficking, cyber crimes, spousal and child abuse, childhood obesity and bullying, and develops legislative strategies to improve and inspire Georgia's communities.
