A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-6-49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 following too closely, so as to provide that such action shall be a punishable offense only if
- 3 such activity results in contact with another vehicle; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 40-6-49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to following too
- 8 closely, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 9 "(a) The driver of a motor vehicle shall not follow another vehicle more closely than is
- reasonable and prudent, having due regard for the speed of such vehicles and the traffic
- upon and the condition of the highway; provided, however, that such activity shall be a
- 12 chargeable offense only if such activity results in or is connected to a physical contact with
- 13 <u>another motor vehicle."</u>

SECTION 2.

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
