A RESOLUTION

1 Commending AAmir Greene and inviting him to be recognized by the House of
2 Representatives; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, AAmir Greene is the state recipient of the Technical College System of
4 Georgia's 2013 Georgia Occupational Award of Leadership (GOAL), which is the first
5 program of its type in the nation to honor outstanding technical college students; and

6 WHEREAS, GOAL brings together Georgia's business, government, and industry leaders
7 with this state's technical colleges to celebrate technical education's vital impact on Georgia's
8 workforce, prosperity, and future; and

9 WHEREAS, for 42 years, the GOAL program has served as an excellent example of a true
10 partnership between business, industry, and higher education; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Greene was selected from among 26 Technical College System of Georgia
12 GOAL winners who have each demonstrated excellent academic and leadership abilities at
13 their respective technical colleges; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Greene is a telecommunications engineering technology student from
15 Albany Technical College, where he enrolled to receive the very best training necessary to
16 acquire the knowledge and skills that will afford him a secure future in his chosen profession;

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Greene will serve as an ambassador for technical education in Georgia,
19 representing more than 151,000 Technical College System of Georgia students who benefit
20 from technical education programs at colleges throughout this state; and

21 WHEREAS, in pursuing his education, Mr. Greene brought honor to himself, his family,
22 Albany Technical College, and the entire Technical College System of Georgia, which he
23 represents as Georgia's outstanding technical college student for 2013.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body commend AAmir Greene for his many achievements, extend their
26 sincerest best wishes for his continued success, and invite him to be recognized by the House
27 of Representatives at a date and time designated by the Speaker of the House of
28 Representatives.
