A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Capitol Commission, Pastor Ron J. Bigalke, and Jim
2 Young; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Capitol Commission is a charitable and religious nonprofit entity whose mission
4 is reaching the Capitol communities of the United States and the world with the good news
5 of God's grace through faith in Jesus Christ; and

6 WHEREAS, many of the men serving with Capitol Commission have more than a decade
7 of experience ministering to political leaders in the United States; and

8 WHEREAS, the ministry of Capitol Commission presently has a pastoral presence in
9 twenty-two state capitols with full-time ministers who serve as pastors and missionaries to
10 the entire Capitol community, including the General Assembly and its staff and agencies; and
11 WHEREAS, the Capitol Commission Day at the Georgia Statehouse on Tuesday,
12 February 11, 2014, is organized as an opportunity to learn about reaching Capitol
13 communities for Christ, in addition to the Church meeting and praying with their elected
14 officials; and

15 WHEREAS, the mission of Capitol Commission is to evangelize those who have not yet
16 experienced a personal relationship with Jesus Christ (Romans 1:16); and

17 WHEREAS, the mission of Capitol Commission is to establish those who have a desire to
18 grow in their faith and in their knowledge of the Scriptures (Colossians 2:6-7); and

19 WHEREAS, the mission of Capitol Commission is to equip those who have been called to
20 spiritual leadership (Ephesians 4:11-12); and

21 WHEREAS, the mission of Capitol Commission is to enable and encourage the Church to
22 participate in the process with them (1 Timothy 2:1-4); and

23 WHEREAS, the mission of Capitol Commission is to enlist businesses, churches, and
24 individuals to become strategic prayer and financial partners (2 Corinthians 8:3-6); and

25 WHEREAS, the mission of Capitol Commission is to engage those who desire to participate
26 in the ministry by offering their time and talents (Matthew 25:20); and

27 WHEREAS, the mission of Capitol Commission is to entreat God to bless all facets of the
28 ministry as each state minister looks to Him for guidance, ways, and wisdom to bring Him
29 glory (1 Chronicles 4:10); and

30 WHEREAS, the mission of Capitol Commission is to enjoy the opportunity to witness God
31 move in supernatural ways (Psalms 37:4-6).

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
33 commend the ministry of Capitol Commission, Pastor Ron Bigalke, and Pastor Jim Young
34 for their dedicated service to the entire Capitol community and extend to them their sincere
35 thanks and best wishes for continued success.
