## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Dedicating the Stanton Springs Parkway; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Stanton Springs spans 1,620 acres of gently rolling countryside near Covington,  
3 Social Circle, Monticello, and Madison, Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Stanton Springs incorporates specific areas for residential, light  
5 business/industrial/distribution, commercial/retail, and office uses in mid- to low-rise  
6 buildings that blend gracefully with their surrounding environment; and
- 7 WHEREAS, this development stands as one of Georgia's premier economic development  
8 achievements, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that a road be dedicated in its honor.
- 9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
10 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 12/U.S. Route 278 in Newton  
11 County from .7 miles south of Interstate Route 20 at Exit 101 to the Walton County line  
12 north of Interstate Route 20 is dedicated as the Stanton Springs Parkway.
- 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
14 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Stanton Springs Parkway.
- 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
16 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Department of  
17 Transportation.
