## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Cheri Anderson Maloy on the occasion of her retirement; and  
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Cheri Anderson Maloy has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable  
4 hours of her time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as  
5 evidenced by her 34 years of superlative service to the State of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, she has been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital role that she  
7 has played and her deep personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, for more than three decades, Cheri has served with honor and distinction with  
9 several agencies of the State of Georgia; and

10 WHEREAS, she began her career at the Georgia Residential Finance Authority (GRFA) on  
11 December 27, 1977, as the administrative assistant to the Section 8 Rental Assistance  
12 program; and

13 WHEREAS, Cheri served as the assistant to the finance director of the GRFA when it was  
14 placed with the Georgia Housing and Finance Authority (GHFA) on July 1, 1991; and

15 WHEREAS, the GHFA was merged with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs  
16 (DCA) as of July 1996; and

17 WHEREAS, she became the executive assistant to the commissioner in 1997 where she  
18 stayed until October 1, 2001, when she transferred from the DCA to the newly created  
19 Department of Motor Vehicle Safety (DMVS) as the administrative assistant in the executive  
20 division; and

21 WHEREAS, Cheri then became the executive assistant to the commissioner of the DMVS  
22 in 2003 and remained in that role after the DMVS became the Department of Driver Services  
23 (DDS) on July 1, 2005; and

24 WHEREAS, Cheri has provided exemplary service to six DMVS and DDS commissioners,  
25 the Board of Driver Services, and all of their customers; and

26 WHEREAS, her significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable patience  
27 and diplomacy, her sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this state have earned her the  
28 respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

29 WHEREAS, Cheri is united in love and marriage to her husband Ralph, and they are blessed  
30 with a son Sam and his wife Deanna, who have four boys, Adam, Ryan, Noah, and Alex; and  
31 a daughter Suzanne and her husband Matt, who have two boys and two girls, Jack, Luke,  
32 Charis, and Reagan; and

33 WHEREAS, her leadership and vision will be sorely missed upon the occasion of her  
34 retirement, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that her outstanding accomplishments be  
35 appropriately recognized.
