A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 19 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the regulation of the practice of law, so as to provide that creation and distribution
- 3 of certain self-help legal documents is not unlawful if a disclaimer is provided; to provide
- 4 for a civil action for damages; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 5 for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 3 of Chapter 19 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 9 regulation of the practice of law, is amended by adding new Code sections to read as follows:
- 10 "<u>15-19-59.</u>
- 11 The design, creation, assembly, completion, publication, distribution, display, or sale,
- including by means of an Internet website, of self-help legal written materials, books,
- documents, forms, computer software, or similar products shall not constitute a violation
- of this article or give rise to a private cause of action pursuant to Code Section 15-19-60
- if such products clearly and conspicuously state that they are not a substitute for the advice
- of an attorney.
- 17 <u>15-19-60.</u>
- Any person damaged by a violation of this article or a violation of the Supreme Court's
- rules or opinions governing the unlicensed practice of law shall be entitled to maintain a
- 20 <u>civil action to recover damages and reasonable attorney's fees."</u>
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
