A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-8-96 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 taxation of property in consolidated governments and change in tax rates, so as to provide
- 3 for a certain exemption for increased sales and use tax; to provide for applicability; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 48-8-96 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to taxation of
- 8 property in consolidated governments and change in tax rates, is amended in subsection (h)
- 9 by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
- 10 "(3) In the case of increase from 1 percent to 2 percent pursuant to referendum held prior
- 11 to January 1, 2011, the amount in excess of the initial 1 percent sales and use tax shall not
- 12 apply to the furnishing for value to the public of any room or rooms, lodgings, or
- 13 <u>accommodations which are subject to taxation under Article 3 of Chapter 13 of this title.</u>
- 14 This exemption shall become effective on July 1, 2014, and shall not be construed as to
- be applied retroactively."

16 SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
