A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Jane Reynolds Hemmer; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Jane Reynolds Hemmer is a Gainesville native and a former Georgia state
3 senator; and

4 WHEREAS, she has been named a Gainesville Woman of Distinction honoree by the Girl
5 Scouts of Historic Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, the Girl Scouts Woman of Distinction award honors a woman who embodies
7 the values presented in the Girl Scout Promise and Law and who serves as an excellent role
8 model for girls; and

9 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hemmer is a dedicated community servant who has served on various
10 boards, including a leadership role as the former Hall County Commissioner from
11 1987-1991; and

12 WHEREAS, she serves as the current president of White Sulphur Properties, Inc.; and

13 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hemmer studied at the Medical College of Georgia, where she earned a
14 bachelor's degree in medical technology, and at the University of Georgia, where she earned
15 a degree in anthropology; and

16 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, she is an active member of Grace Episcopal
17 Church; and

18 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hemmer has been united in love and marriage to Dr. John L. Hemmer for
19 45 years and is blessed with two remarkable children, Lee Hemmer and Reverend Mary
20 Hemmer Demmler, and six wonderful grandchildren; and

21 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hemmer's significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable
22 patience and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the
23 citizens of this state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and
24 associates; and

25 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
26 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
