A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Georgia Chapter of Association of Physicians of Pakistani Descent of
2 North America (GA-APPNA) and its members and recognizing February 19, 2014, as
3 GA-APPNA Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, many representatives of the Georgia Chapter of Association of Physicians of
5 Pakistani Descent of North America will be at the state capitol to meet with legislators; and

6 WHEREAS, there are currently nearly 1,000 Pakistani physicians in the State of Georgia;

8 WHEREAS, members of the Georgia Chapter of Association of Physicians of Pakistani
9 Descent of North America are practicing in a wide range of settings, such as nonprofit,
10 community pharmacies, hospitals, nursing homes, academia, managed care, the
11 pharmaceutical industry, and private practice; and

12 WHEREAS, GA-APPNA physicians voluntarily provide exceptional care to their patients
13 in underserved areas; and

14 WHEREAS, GA-APPNA physicians are the most knowledgeable, well-respected, and
15 among the most ethical health care professionals in the State of Georgia; and

16 WHEREAS, GA-APPNA physicians established APPNA CARES Clinic Day to provide free
17 medical examinations and flu vaccines; and

18 WHEREAS, GA-APPNA physicians of Georgia have consistently provided outstanding care
19 to their patients; and

20 WHEREAS, the Georgia Chapter of Association of Physicians of Pakistani Descent of North
21 America was founded in 1998 and is the professional association representing these
22 physicians of all practice settings.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body commend the Georgia Chapter of Association of Physicians of
25 Pakistani Descent of North America and its members for 16 years of service to the patients
26 of Georgia and recognize Wednesday, February 19, 2014, as GA-APPNA Day at the state
27 capitol.
