#### A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Mr. Edward W. "Kip" Klein III and dedicating a road in his honor; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Edward W. "Kip" Klein III has long been recognized by the citizens of this  
4 state for the vital role that he played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the  
5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, after graduating cum laude from the University of Virginia, Mr. Klein earned  
7 a law degree from the University of Georgia where he joined the gridiron society and studied  
8 at the Hague International Academy of International Law; and

9 WHEREAS, a native of Atlanta, Mr. Klein practiced family law in Marietta and received the  
10 Angels in Adoption award for the State of Georgia in 2000 for his dedicated work to helping  
11 families through the adoption process; and

12 WHEREAS, he ably and adeptly served his constituents and the State of Georgia as a  
13 Representative for three terms beginning with his election in 1990; and

14 WHEREAS, a community leader, Mr. Klein was chosen to be the envoy to Kuwait for the  
15 Atlanta Olympic Committee and to interact on a good will mission on behalf of the state in  
16 the European Parliament by the European Community Visitors Programme; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
18 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized with the dedicating of  
19 a road in his honor.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
21 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 92 in Cobb County from its

22 intersection with Interstate 75 to the Paulding County line is dedicated as the Kip Klein  
23 Memorial Highway.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
25 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Kip Klein Memorial Highway.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
27 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the family of Mr. Edward W. "Kip" Klein  
28 III and to the Department of Transportation.
