A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Reginald S. Carter, Sr., and dedicating a bridge in his memory; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Reginald S. Carter, Sr., was recognized by the citizens of this state for the
4 vital role that he played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare of the
5 citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
7 States Armed Forces for over 25 years during World War II and the Vietnam War; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Carter diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his
9 time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
10 dramatically by his superlative service with the Taylor County Board of Education and the
11 Tax Assessors Board; and

12 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
13 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary life of this
15 distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating a bridge in his memory.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
17 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the southbound bridge on State Route 3 over Cedar Creek
18 in Taylor County is dedicated as the Reginald S. Carter, Sr., Memorial Bridge.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
20 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Reginald S. Carter, Sr.,
21 Memorial Bridge.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
23 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the family of Mr. Reginald
24 S. Carter, Sr., and to the Department of Transportation.
