## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the contributions of the Republic of Turkey and the Turkic American Federation
- 2 of Southeast and encouraging the creation of a Georgian-Turkish Friendship Task Force; and
- 3 for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, the Republic of Turkey and the United States of America are long-standing
- 5 allies, both dearly cherishing the universal values of freedom, democracy, and human rights;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, in its alliances with the United States, the Republic of Turkey has demonstrated
- 8 its commitment to world peace and liberty as well as its secular and religious tolerance of
- 9 others; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Republic of Turkey has the world's 15th largest economy and Europe's sixth
- 11 largest economy, is a valued trading partner with the State of Georgia, and is to be
- 12 commended for its contributions to the global economy; and
- WHEREAS, the State of Georgia and the Republic of Turkey have enjoyed a strong, vibrant,
- and mutually beneficial economic relationship with the prospect of further growth; and
- 15 WHEREAS, it is the custom of the State of Georgia to welcome all who come to the state,
- 16 especially those who come in the interest of friendship and commerce; and
- 17 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Georgia to further cultivate the good
- 18 relationship between Georgia and the Republic of Turkey and other Turkish nations; and
- 19 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Georgia Legislature to recognize the contributions of our
- 20 nation's allies and the value of maintaining beneficial relationships with allies of the State
- of Georgia, such as the contributions made by the Republic of Turkey and the value of the
- 22 positive relationship with this ally; and

23 WHEREAS, the Turkic American Federation of Southeast (TAFS) is an independent

- 24 nonprofit organization that facilitates the mutually beneficial economic relationship between
- 25 Georgia and Turkey; and
- 26 WHEREAS, TAFS's mission is promoting cultural, educational, academic, business, social
- 27 and arts relations, and organizing events and activities to bring together the American,
- 28 Turkish, Turkic, and Eurasian communities within the United States, and TAFS represents
- 29 12 member organizations in five states: Georgia, Florida, Tennessee, South Carolina, and
- 30 Alabama; and
- 31 WHEREAS, TAFS brings people together by hosting public programs and private events
- 32 featuring leaders and experts with diverse views on a wide range of global and regional
- 33 topics through task forces, executive forums, luncheons, conferences, studies, and leadership
- 34 dialogue; and
- 35 WHEREAS, a Georgian-Turkish Friendship Task Force can further long-standing
- 36 Georgia-Republic of Turkey relations, build upon time-honored friendships, and promote
- 37 cultural, educational, academic, political, and economic relations between Georgia and
- 38 Turkey; and
- 39 WHEREAS, a Georgian-Turkish Task Force, with TAFS serving as the initial network
- 40 coordinator, will provide House and Senate members with the opportunity to strengthen
- 41 Georgia-Republic of Turkey relations and address issues that concern Turkish Americans in
- 42 Georgia, while coordinating hospitality and educational events and exchanges with TAFS.
- 43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 44 the members of this body recognize the contributions of the Republic of Turkey and the
- 45 Turkic American Federation of Southeast for its efforts to promote intercultural
- 46 understanding and goodwill, and extend best wishes for a successful and memorable
- 47 Turkish-Georgian Friendship Dinner on February 26, 2014, in Atlanta, Georgia.
- 48 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of this body also encourage the creation
- 49 of a Georgian-Turkish Friendship Task Force by members of the Georgia Legislature to
- 50 further long-standing Georgia-Republic of Turkey relations, build upon time-honored
- 51 friendships, and promote cultural, educational, academic, political, and economic relations
- 52 between Georgia and Turkey.
