A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 2 of Article 13 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to special provisions for motorcycles, so as to repeal certain provisions
- 3 relating handlebars; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 5 SECTION 1.
- 6 Part 2 of Article 13 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 7 relating to special provisions for motorcycles, is amended by revising Code Section
- 8 40-6-314, relating to footrests and handlebars, as follows:
- 9 "40-6-314.
- 10 (a) Any motorcycle carrying a passenger, other than in a sidecar or enclosed cab, shall be
- equipped with footrests for such passenger.
- 12 (b) No person shall operate any motorcycle with handlebars more than 15 inches in height
- 13 above that portion of the seat occupied by the operator or with a backrest more commonly
- 14 known as a sissy bar that is designed in such a way as to create a sharp point at its apex."
- SECTION 2.
- 16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
