A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To provide that future elections for the office of coroner of Randolph County shall be
- 2 nonpartisan elections; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 3 purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 5 SECTION 1.
- 6 All elections for the office of coroner of Randolph County conducted after January 1, 2015,
- 7 shall be nonpartisan elections as provided for in Code Section 21-2-139 of the O.C.G.A.
- 8 Such nonpartisan elections shall be held in conjunction with the November general election
- 9 immediately preceding expiration of the term of office and conducted as provided in
- 10 Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code."
- 11 SECTION 2.
- 12 Nothing in this Act shall affect the term of office of the coroner of Randolph County in office
- on January 1, 2015. The sitting coroner shall serve out the term of office for which he or she
- was elected and shall be eligible to succeed himself or herself as provided in this Act.
- SECTION 3.
- 16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
