# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To authorize the City of Winder to exercise all redevelopment and other powers under

2 Article IX, Section II, Paragraph VII(b) of the Constitution and Chapter 44 of Title 36 of the

3 O.C.G.A., the "Redevelopment Powers Law," as amended; to provide for a referendum; to

4 provide effective dates, to provide for automatic repeal under certain circumstances; to repeal

5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

#### **SECTION 1.**

8 The City of Winder shall be and is authorized to exercise all redevelopment and other powers 9 under Chapter 44 of Title 36 of the O.C.G.A., the "Redevelopment Powers Law," as 10 amended. The intention of this Act is to authorize the City of Winder to undertake and carry 11 out community redevelopment, to create tax allocation districts, to issue tax allocation bonds, 12 and to incur other obligations within the meaning of and as fully permitted under the provisions of Article IX, Section II, Paragraph VII(b) of the Constitution of the State of 13 14 Georgia of 1983, as amended, and to authorize the City of Winder to exercise redevelopment 15 powers as fully as the "Redevelopment Powers Law" may now or hereafter permit and not to limit any redevelopment powers permitted under the "Redevelopment Powers Law." 16

#### **SECTION 2.**

The election superintendent of the City of Winder shall call and conduct an election as 18 provided in this section for the purpose of submitting this Act to the electors of the City of 19 20 Winder for approval or rejection. The election superintendent shall conduct such election on the earliest practical date under Code Section 21-2-540 of the O.C.G.A. and shall issue 21 22 the call and conduct such election as provided by general law. The superintendent shall 23 cause the date and purpose of the election to be published once a week for two weeks immediately preceding the date thereof in the official organ of the City of Winder. The 24 25 ballot shall have written or printed thereon the words:

"() YES Shall the Act be approved which authorizes the City of Winder to exercise
redevelopment powers under the 'Redevelopment Powers Law,' as it may
() NO be amended from time to time, for the purpose of improving economic and
social conditions in depressed areas within the county?"

All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and all persons desiring 30 to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes cast on 31 32 such question are for approval of the Act, then Section 1 of this Act shall become of full 33 force and effect immediately. If Section 1 of this Act is not so approved or if the election is not conducted as provided in this section, Section 1 of this Act shall not become effective 34 35 and this Act shall be automatically repealed on the first day of January immediately following such election date. The expense of such election shall be borne by the City of 36 Winder. It shall be the election superintendent's duty to certify the result thereof to the 37 38 Secretary of State.

### **SECTION 3.**

40 Except as otherwise provided in Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall become effective upon

41 its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

42 **SECTION 4.** 

43 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
